

03_Operation Guide 1 of 3


Float is arguably our easiest moving wall system to use...

It has no turning key, no buttons and no seals, making it extremely fast and simple to move.

This guide assumes your Float system is stacked prior to operating. If the panels are already moved from the stacked position, simply complete the following process in reverse.

Step 1

To move the first panel, simply hold each edge with one hand steadily move the panel along the ceiling track.



Step 2

When you have moved the first panel to it's desired location, use the manual operated foot bolt to lock the panel in position.

Please note that not all Float panels have foot bolts – this is dependent on the customer's requirements. If this is the case for your system, your panels will hang steadily in position.





Step 3

Repeat steps 1 and 2 to move any other panels out of the stacking area if required.

Take care that the panels never collide harshly. This can cause costly profile or board damage.

It's as simple as that!



06_Cleaning & Maintenance


Float requires very little attention with the obvious exception of keeping the track free of dirt and objects.

All systems featuring panels with a standard finish (including Whisperand pinnable-panelled varieties) can be cleaned with a damp cloth and dried with a dry cloth immediately after.

We recommend that you avoid scrubbing and the use of bleach-based cleaning products.

07_Fabric Care

Float systems with a fabric finish are easy to clean.


The fabric can be cleaned with either a dry cloth or a specialist cleaning product, or a dry vacuum.

You can also remove the fabric – it can be peeled off, rolled up, stored away and even put in a washing machine (subject to type).

Removing the fabric is simple. Locate the plastic tab attached (normally found on of the corners) and simply pull the cover from its frame.

To replace, just push the plastic beading back into the frame.
