
All materials are guaranteed for 12 months from the date of installation, with the exception of damage caused as a result of misuse or neglect.

03_Operation Guide

Once installed, Tempo does not require any special guidelines for use.

Tempo is supplied and installed as a set. Each angular acoustic panel is set into a metal channel, which is attached — via a fixing screw - to both the wall and ceiling.

As such, be mindful of their fixing point and do not place any unnecessary stress upon the panels as this may cause them to come loose and cause damage to the wall/ceiling.






04_Cleaning and Maintenance

As each Tempo panels is fabric-wrapped rather than painted, they little in the way of cleaning or maintenance.

You can use a vacuum cleaner with a soft brush attachment to remove surface dirt and dust, and any light stains can be removed by using a cloth and warm water.

A proprietary carpet spot cleaner may also be used, though a small area should be tested to ensure that the fabric is not adversely affected.

Do not use bleach or similarly harsh chemicals as these may permanently stain the fabric.
